Know the signs for a change in your condition.*



You're in the right lane!

- Take medications as ordered
- Follow your prescribed diet
- Keep all doctor appointments, especially after hospitalization
- Get annual flu shot
- Get COVID vaccine as recommended by your medical provider
- If age >65 or have history of pneumonia, get the pneumonia vaccine as recommended by your medical provider

Call us if you have:

- Any new symptom
- Vomiting, diarrhea, or flu-like symptoms
- A visit to the emergency room or admission to the hospital
- A new prescribed medication or change in dosage or frequency
- A fall (with or without injury)
- Increased shortness of breath
- Unusual swelling in legs or feet
- A productive or frothy cough
- New congestion
- Sudden weakness, dizziness, or drowsiness
- Sweating spells
- Increased redness or swelling
- A temperature of 100 degrees or more
- Increased urination
- Change in urine (odor, color, flank pain, inability to urinate)
- Other _____



Call 911 if you have:

- A fall with severe injury
- Chest pain that medication or rest does not help
- Severe difficulty in breathing
- Severe or prolonged bleeding or pain
- Other _____

Caregivers — call 911 immediately if the patient is not responsive.

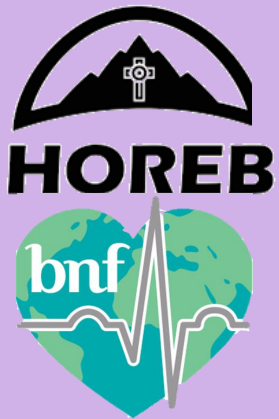
