

“Sandra’s Bags” Ministry – Providing Hope and Comfort

“Sandra’s Bags” were first created in memory of Sandra P Inge who while valiantly fighting a battle against Breast Cancer brought a tote bag of items for a new chemo infusion patient each time received chemo. Her Mother Georgette Perkins, RN and the Waccamaw BNF chapter in South Carolina are continuing Sandra’s ministry with “Sandra’s Bags” for five local infusion centers. New Testaments have been donated by the local Gideon’s Auxiliary as well as handmade tote bags and handmade quilts and soft blankets from two churches. A handcrafted stained glass cancer ribbon is attached to each bag and a tag telling the Sandra’s story. We provide 12” of ribbon in each of the cancer colors for attaching the glass cancer ribbons. Bags are distributed by BNF members to the infusion centers and given out by the lead nurse when a new infusion patient arrives.

Bag items include: In addition to the New Testament, cancer ribbon, and blanket or quilt - soft socks, lip balm, hand lotion, tissue packet, pencil and puzzle book, a small notebook, a pen and journal, mints, gum, a rubber “BNF is Praying for You” bracelet, and a small bottle of water.
